Business Arising from The Minutes

Library Update During the recent meeting, Mayor Saunders provided an update regarding the building located at 22 Price Street. He reported that he had informed the original donors of the property that, after careful assessment, the building has been deemed unsuitable for use as a future library.

In light of this determination, Mayor Saunders reached out to the donors to discuss potential next steps, particularly regarding the possibility of selling the property. He asked the donors to consider how they would prefer the proceeds to be used if the building were sold, ensuring their wishes are respected in the process.

Page 1 The Community of Three Rivers December 4, 2024 At the time of the meeting, Mayor Saunders noted that he had not yet received a response from the donors. He emphasized that any decisions regarding the building or its potential sale would remain pending until further communication with the donors could take place.

Motion To Transfer Funds from Gas Tax - Petitcodiac Firehall Mini splits

BACKGROUND: At a meeting of Council on November 20, 2024, a motion was made that The Community of Three Rivers move forward with the purchase and installation of 2 mini split systems along with any required electrical work at a cost of \$11,600 plus hst at the Petitcodiac Fire Hall.

Councillor Murphy moved TO APPROVE THE TRANSFER OF \$12,097.58 FROM THE Village of Petitcodiac's Gas Tax Fund to the Community of Three Rivers General Operating Fund for the purchase and installation of 2 Samsung Max Heat 3.0 mini split systems along with any required electrical work at the Petitcodiac Fire Hall. This amount represents the subtotal plus our portion of the HST. Seconded by Councillor Silverthorn.

Motion To Transfer Funds from Gas Tax – Railway Avenue Sewer Project

BACKGROUND: A motion was made on September 18, 2024, to award the contract to L. Sanford and sons ltd for the railway avenue sewer upgrade project in preparation for the new medical center

Councillor Murphy moved to approve the transfer of \$162,206.48 from the Village of Petitcodiac's gas tax fund to the community of three rivers general operating fund to cover the cost of the railway avenue sewer upgrade project. New Business

Unsightly Premises By-Law Council was presented with a draft of *The Community of Three Rivers Unsightly Premises By-Law No. 2025-08*. Council was asked to review the document in preparation for a future motion to formally pass the by-law in the new year. Council was encouraged to provide feedback or suggest amendments during the review period to ensure the by-law meets the community's needs effectively before final approval.

Motion to Approve General Operating Budget 2025

On a motion made by Councillor Murphy and seconded by Councillor Silverthorn, THIS IS TO CERTIFY that on the 4th day of December, 2024 the Council of the Local Government of The Community of Three Rivers resolved that the sum of \$4,227,793 be the total operating budget of the Local Government, that the sum of \$3,422,084 be the Warrant of the Local Government for the ensuing year, and that the tax rate(s) for the Local Government be as follows: Petitcodiac \$1.2983, Elgin Center \$1.0832, Elgin Parish \$1.0465 and Salisbury \$1.0116. The Council orders and directs the levying by the Minister of Local Government of said amount on real property liable to taxation under the Assessment Act within the local government of The Community of Three Rivers.

Adopted this 4th day of December 2024 by the Council of the local government of The Community of Three Rivers.

Motion to Pass Sewer Budget 2025

Letter from CN – Re. Upgrading Rail Crossing on Spring Street The municipality received an email that CN is contemplating a modification/installation to the existing crossing located on Spring Street, Petitcodiac. Included was a Warning System Installation/Modification Agreement with a potential estimated cost share between CN and The Community of Three Rivers of \$93,949. A response was sent requesting more detailed information, but nothing was received at the time of the meeting. Council requested nothing be done until more information is available.

Future Street PID 70549225

BACKGROUND In 2020 an application was received to extend Meadowview Drive for the purpose of creating a subdivision. This project did not move forward. However, as a result of the application, land for public purposes and a future street were set aside. It was understood that the land that was set aside for a public street was going to be vested back to the developer because there was no intention to develop it (it leads onto the WCAF property) and it could be used as part of a building lot. There has been renewed interest in development on this piece of land, so we have been asked to make a motion that PID 70549225 be vested back to the developer. The developer will pay legal fees to have this done.

Councillor Murphy made a motion that The Community Of Three Rivers transfer ownership of PID 70549225, a proposed future street, back to the developer, allowing it to be consolidated with their existing piece of land for the purpose of future housing development, with the developer covering all legal fees associated with the transaction.
