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#### Motion to Approve General Operating Budget 2024

On a motion made by Councillor Murphy and seconded by Councillor Silverthorn, this is to certify that on the 15th day of November, 2023 the Council of the Local Government of The Community of Three Rivers resolved that the sum of \$3,797,831 be the total operating budget of the Local Government, that the sum of \$3,046,798 be the Warrant of the Local Government for the ensuing year, and that the tax rate(s) for the Local Government be as follows: Petitcodiac \$1.2973, Elgin Center \$1.0333, Elgin Parish \$0.9967 and Salisbury \$0.9899. The Council orders and directs the levying by the Minister of Local Government of said amount on real property liable to taxation under the Assessment Act within the local government of The Community of Three Rivers.
